I am pleased to announce that the new California State Fire Marshal approved "**FIRELINE SAFETY AWARENESS FOR THE HIRED VENDOR**" course will be offered through Porterville College again this year.

This one-day course was developed by CAL FIRE and the U.S. Forest Service in late 2010 to replace the **Hired Equipment Operator Fireline Safety Awareness** training that was formerly offered by those agencies. To ensure that this training meets the highest standards possible, Porterville College will employ only well qualified off-duty professional firefighters to instruct this course.

As detailed on the attached flyer, Porterville College has scheduled four one-day class sessions in March 2012. At present we do not anticipate holding classes in Kernville this year. ALL classes are being conducted in the Theatre on the Porterville College campus.

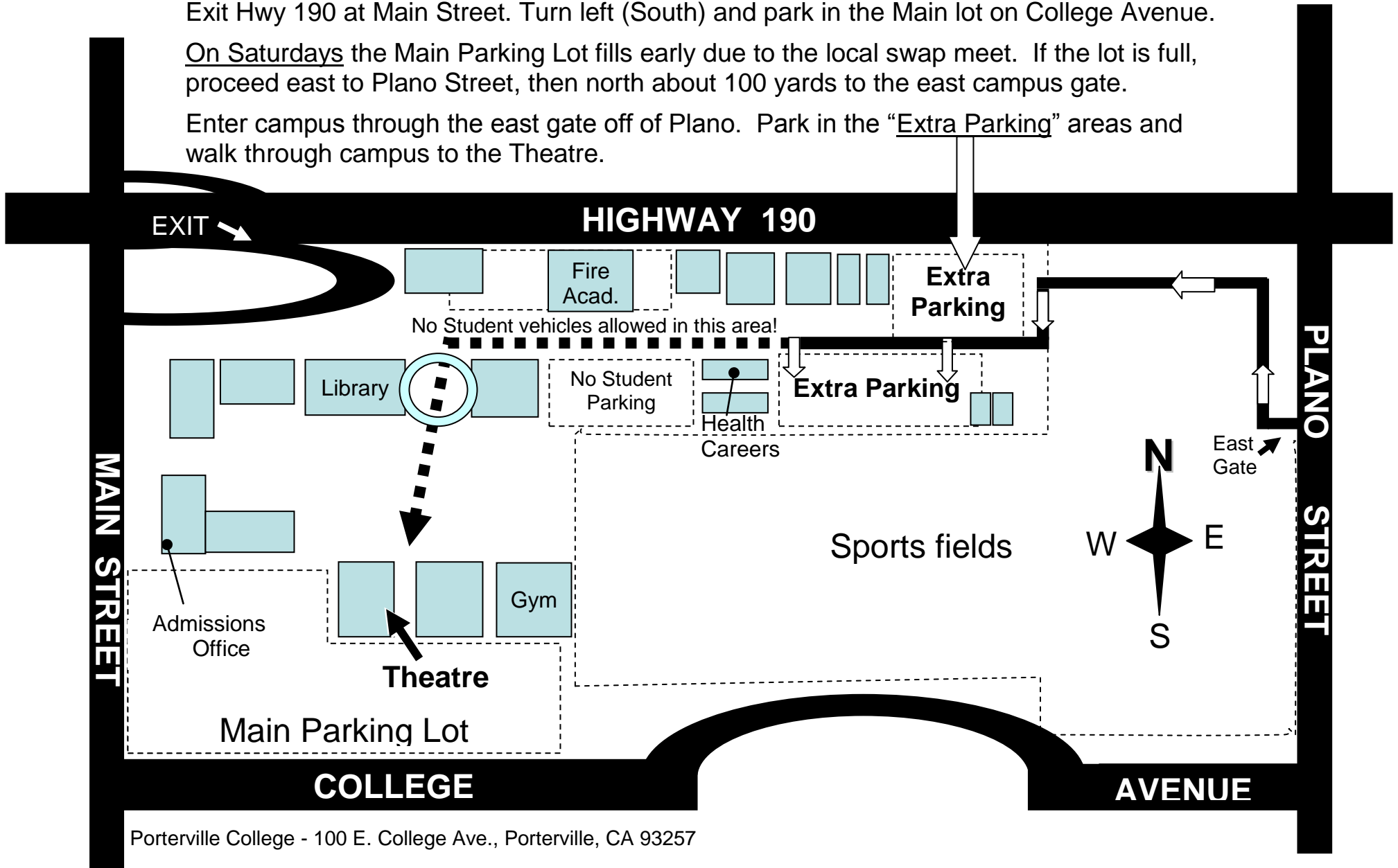
Porterville College Theatre and Parking

Porterville College is located at Hwy 190 and Main Street, 2 miles east of Hwy 65.

Exit Hwy 190 at Main Street. Turn left (South) and park in the Main lot on College Avenue.

On Saturdays the Main Parking Lot fills early due to the local swap meet. If the lot is full, proceed east to Plano Street, then north about 100 yards to the east campus gate.

Enter campus through the east gate off of Plano. Park in the "Extra Parking" areas and walk through campus to the Theatre.
