Program Strengths and Areas for Improvement:

The general speech courses had during the 04-05 calendar year 1 full time faculty, 1 faculty with the speech courses as part of another load, and 1 adjunct faculty.

The Drama course had 1 full time faculty

We need to increase the commitment of faculty to the basic course to at least 2 full time faculty. The interpersonal course is offered f/f and online and there needs to be a commitment to this arrangement into the future.

The Drama class is the last vestiges of a Drama program at Porterville College. While it is doubtful if there are enough graduates from the local High Schools to fill out the program/courses we are able to offer, a commitment should be made to give support to this idea.

In the 06-07 academic year we are offering 2 sections of Intro. To Theatre.
