

## Embedding YouTube Video on Your Etudes Course Home Page

1. Go to YouTube and find the video you want to use
  - a. The video you choose must have embedding enabled. You will know this if you see the word "Embed" and underneath it a text box. This will be to the right of the video.
2. Copy the embed address by clicking once in the Embed text box and using your preferred copy command (e.g. Ctrl+C, Right-click»Copy, etc.)
3. Open a new Word document and paste the embed code.
4. Delete everything before **http://**
5. Delete everything after **en**
  - a. EXAMPLE (Note: The struck-through text is deleted and the only thing remaining is the bolded blue letters, numbers and symbols.)

6. Copy this remaining code.
7. Login to your class site's Homepage and click on the **Options** link above the homepage box.
8. Paste the code you just copied from your edited word document into the **Site Info URL** box.
9. The suggested frame height setting is 450 pixels.
10. Click **Update Options**.
