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# PORTERVILLE COLLEGE – A.A./A.S. GENERAL EDUCATION CHECKLIST

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## Graduation Requirements

1. An Associate in Arts or Associate in Science degree is awarded to those who complete a minimum of sixty (60) credits of graded courses with at least a 2.0 grade point average.
2. A minimum of twelve (12) credits must be earned in residence at this institution.

Students may graduate under the general degree requirements in effect:

1. At the time for first enrollment as long as continuous enrollment is maintained, **OR**
2. If continuous enrollment is broken from the first enrollment, under the requirements in effect from the time continuous enrollment is re-established and maintained, **OR**
3. Under the requirements in effect at the time of graduation

Continuous attendance means no more than a one semester absence within an academic year including summer sessions. Any academic record symbol (A-F, P, NP, I, IP, RD, W) shall constitute enrollment

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Degree requirements include the following: courses in your **major**, one of the three **general education patterns**, and the **additional campus graduation requirements** as follows.

Combining these areas and, if necessary, elective courses must equal **60 total credits** with a minimum total grade point average of 2.0 in order to graduate. Credits earned in courses numbered P070-P089 do not count toward graduation.

- **Major Requirements**

The courses required for your major are listed in the college catalog. You are encouraged to purchase a catalog the first term you enroll and keep this throughout your education at Porterville College. The catalog can also be accessed via the college website.

- **General Education Patterns**

There are three general education patterns you may select from to complete your requirements. Your specific academic goal will determine which one of these checklists to follow. The table below will help you decide which checklist is more appropriate for you:

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Goal: **Not planning to transfer** after completing the degree.

Checklist: Follow the **PC General Education** Checklist.

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Goal: **Transfer to a California State University (CSU)** after completing the degree.

Checklist: Follow either the **CSU General Education Breadth** or the **Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC)** checklist.

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Goal: **Transfer to a University of California (UC) California State College (CSU) or independent college** after completing the degree.

Checklist: Follow the **IGETC** checklist.

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- **Additional Campus Graduation Requirements**

In addition to the major and general education requirements indicated above, you must also complete the following campus graduation requirements: **Education** (see **PC General Education Checklist**) **Multicultural Studies** (see **PC General Education Checklist**); and 3 units in Physical Education or HLED P112.

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## Associate in Science Degree

The Associate in Science degree in Biological and Physical Sciences is suggested for students who plan to continue their studies in the sciences at a four-year university with a goal of obtaining a bachelor's or higher degree in the sciences or a medical related field. The Associate in Science degree In Biological and Physical Sciences may be awarded to students who complete the Porterville College Graduation Requirements for an Associate in Arts degree through any of the three general educational patterns (the Porterville College General Education checklist, CSU General Education Breadth Requirements, or Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum), including major requirements of at least eighteen (18) credits in the biological and physical sciences from the following list (at least one course must be taken from each group):
